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## CA BAP COVID-19 Vaccine Product Ordering Open

The California Bridge Access Program (CA BAP) is providing COVID-19 vaccines at no-cost to uninsured and underinsured adults ages 19 years and older during the 2024 – 2025 respiratory season. **COVID-19 vaccine ordering is now open.** CA BAP providers should submit initial orders by **Friday, September 27.**

CA BAP provider participation, eligibility, and all other CA BAP requirements remain unchanged. [Provider agreements](#) are being extended with the extension of [CA BAP](#): No action from providers is required at this time.
