Suggested Immunization Messages and Resources

Vaccines are a safe way to protect children from serious diseases. It is important for children to be up to date on their recommended vaccines, including the measles-mumps-rubella (MMR) vaccines, especially before international travel. Before international travel, infants 6 – 11 months should receive an early MMR dose followed by the routine 2-dose series, and everyone 12 months and older should receive 2 MMR doses 28 days apart.

CDC and CDPH recommend that individuals over age 65 or who have a weakened immune system receive a second dose of the 2024 – 2025 COVID-19 vaccine, 6 months after the first dose to stay protected from severe illness.
