National Influenza Vaccination Week



December 2 – 6 is <u>National Influenza Vaccination Week!</u> – a time to remind patients to get their <u>updated (2024 - 2025) flu vaccine</u> **before** they gather or travel for the holidays.

Please continue to encourage everyone 6 months and older to get vaccinated against flu, especially older adults, pregnant people, young children, and others at higher risk.

Consider using these patient portal reminders:

Have you gotten your <u>annual flu vaccine</u> yet? There's still time! A flu vaccine
is the best way to help protect yourself and your loved ones against getting

seriously sick from the flu. Ask us about other immunizations you may be due for.

Pregnant patients:

Have you received your <u>annual flu vaccine</u> yet? There's still time!
 Immunizing against flu during pregnancy passes protection to your baby, helping prevent serious illness due to flu in early life when they are most vulnerable. Ask us about other immunizations you may be due for.

Parents of children 6 months and older:

Has your child gotten their <u>annual flu vaccine</u> yet? There's still time! Every
year flu puts thousands of children in the hospital. Making sure your child is
immunized against flu can lower their risk for serious flu complications.
 Some children 6 months - 8 years need 2 doses. Ask us about other
immunizations your child may be due for.
