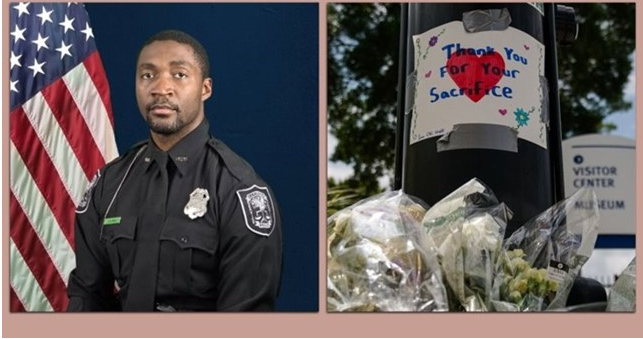

Respiratory Syncytial Virus (RSV) Immunization Updates

Maternal/Pediatric RSV Immunization Season is Starting Soon

RSV immunization is recommended starting:

- September 1-January 31 for pregnant people during weeks 32-36 of pregnancy who haven’t received RSV vaccine during a prior pregnancy.
- October 1-March 31 for infants from birth-8 months whose mothers did not receive prenatal vaccination and infants and children 9-18 months at [high risk](#).

CDC has Adopted ACIP’s Recommendations for Clesrovimab:

- ACIP recommends infants <8 months born during or entering their first RSV season who are not protected by maternal vaccination receive one dose of clesrovimab.
- There is no preferential recommendation between clesrovimab and nirsevimab.

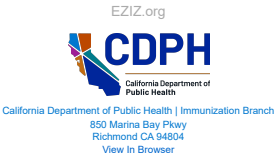
