Time to Gather, Eat Turkey, and Recommend Prenatal Vaccines!

Thanksgiving is a perfect time to celebrate the health and well-being of our growing families. To help protect young infants, strongly recommend that your pregnant patients get immunized against:

- Flu and COVID-19—as soon as possible.
- Pertussis —Tdap is recommended between 27-36 weeks gestation.
- RSV—RSV vaccine is recommended at 32-36 weeks gestation, September through January.

With RSV and pertussis on the rise, prenatal vaccines are a priority. Help your patients with this suggested advice: "I strongly recommend you get vaccinated during pregnancy, which is very safe and passes on protective antibodies to your baby. This will help ensure that your baby is protected against these diseases from birth!"

Novavax Update

CDC has resumed deliveries of Novavax COVID-19 vaccine with a 12/31/2024 expiry, and CDPH had turned ordering back on. Novavax is in the process of requesting a shelf-life extension for lots expiring 12/31/2024 and we will inform you with any updates. To minimize vaccine wastage, order enough vaccine that can be utilized within the expiration date.
