Notification regarding updates to CSCP's Reportable Ingredients List

This is a notification of an update to [CSCP's Reportable Ingredients List \(RIL\)](#). The RIL contains updated chemicals listings from the 23 source authoritative lists cited in the [California Safe Cosmetics Act \(CSCA\)](#) and [Cosmetic Fragrance and Flavor Ingredient Right to Know Act of 2020 \(CFFIRKA\)](#) through April 2026.

For your convenience, you will find a fourth tab labeled "Summary of Updates" in the [downloadable spreadsheet](#) that lists all ingredients that were added to or removed from the RIL since the last update.

Deadline approaching for reporting the 56 most recently listed fragrance allergens

In July 2023, [Annex III of the EU Cosmetics Regulation No. 1223/2009 was amended in Regulation No. 2023/1545](#) to recognize 56 new fragrance allergens. The regulations included a transition timeline for companies to comply with new labeling requirements. CDPH then aligned with the EU's timeline for CFFIRKA fragrance allergen reporting requirements. As the first deadline in the timeline is approaching, this email is a courtesy reminder to cosmetics companies that the new fragrance allergens should be reported as follows:

- Cosmetic products newly introduced to the California market after July 31, 2026, containing one or more of the 56 fragrance allergens [must be reported](#) to the [California Safe Cosmetic Product Database](#). The fragrance allergens are already included in the [Reportable Ingredients List](#).
- Cosmetics products that were previously available in California before July 31, 2026 containing one or more of the 56 fragrance allergens must be reported to the California Safe Cosmetic Product Database starting July 31, 2028.
