Back to School Immunizations: Beat the Rush!



The new school year is just around the corner and now is the time to get pediatric patients caught up on vaccinations! Many children need to catch up to meet school immunization requirements and to stay protected against vaccine-preventable diseases such as whooping cough, measles, and chickenpox.

Appointments may become scarce as the summer break ends, and children could miss days at school waiting to get their immunizations. Your clinic's actions now can make all the difference!

Proactive Back-to-School Strategies to Consider:

- 1. **Use the immunization registry and your EHR** to identify children who missed well child visits and/or recommended immunizations.
- 2. Reach out to schedule in-person appointments using a robocall script, letter, or text.


- 3. **Plan back-to-school immunization catch-up clinics** at convenient times for working parents, including weekends and evenings.
- 4. Administer needed immunizations at ALL visits, not just well-child checks.
- 5. **Designate a certain number of "immunization-only" appointments** each day leading up to school entry.
- 6. Use effective communication techniques. Start with language that assumes a parent will accept vaccines for their child (e.g., "Your child needs three vaccines today."). Be prepared to answer any questions and address concerns. Make a strong recommendation and share reasons why you support immunizations; personal accounts can be persuasive and memorable!
- 7. Foster support for immunizations in your practice by adopting these practices.



Juneteenth Commemoration 2024

Among The United States Independence Day celebrations, we celebrate June 19th, when Union General Gordon Grander announced the end of the Civil War and slavery to thousands of formerly enslaved persons in Texas in 1865. They

were among the last to learn of their independence. Their freedom came more than two years after President Lincoln signed the Emancipation Proclamation, and this day came to be known as Juneteenth.

Black Americans continue to experience the impact of slavery and racism resulting in mistrust in public health. This sentiment contributes to lower vaccination rates among Black Americans compared to their white counterparts. Listen to Meligha Garfield share his experience about spreading awareness of the COVID-19 vaccine in his community.

Please join the California Department of Public Health (CDPH) Immunization Branch as we acknowledge these challenges and their role in immunization disparities, including COVID-19 vaccine, experienced by Black and African-Americans.
