Happy Lunar New Year! If you're headed abroad to celebrate, remember that <u>everyone 6 months and older should be up to date on their MMR</u> (measles-mumpsrubella) vaccine and other recommended vaccines before international travel.

## **Vaccines during Pregnancy: Protecting Maternal and Infant Health**

Join the National Foundation for Infectious Diseases (NFID) and partner organizations, the American College of Obstetricians and Gynecologists (ACOG), and the National Coalition for Infant Health (NCfIH), for a <u>webinar discussion</u> on strategies to help prevent infectious diseases and increase uptake of recommended vaccines during pregnancy. # IMMEDIATE ACTION REQUIRED: Pre-Book 2025 – 2026 VFC Flu Vaccine by Monday, February 3!

Pre-book for the upcoming 2025 – 2026 season is due **by Monday, February 3**. After that, the Vaccines for Children (VFC) Flu Pre-book will no longer be available on your <u>myCAvax</u> account. This is your <u>ONLY</u> chance to let the VFC Program know which flu vaccine is your preferred product and the number of doses you need next season. If your practice does not pre-book and provide us your brand preference, the VFC program will allocate doses based on available supply. After VFC Flu Pre-book is closed, any requests to change your brand preference or allocated product will **not** be accommodated.

Note: If you are a Vaccine Coordinator or Organization Coordinator for more than one location, please ensure that all your locations have pre-booked.

#### Helpful Tips to Complete 2025 – 2026 VFC Flu Vaccine Pre-book:

- Review the <u>myCAvax job-aid</u> for step-by-step instructions and screenshots on how to navigate to the online pre-book form.
- Save time by gathering required information ahead of time and completing the <u>Pre-book Worksheet</u> in advance.

- If you have already submitted your pre-book but need to make any
  corrections, you may resubmit your pre-book on myCAvax as many times as
  needed from now until the February 3rd deadline. After February 3, no
  changes will be accepted.

If your clinic has been affected by ongoing wildfires or power outages and will not be able to pre-book 2025 – 2026 flu vaccine prior to the February 3 due date, please reach out to the VFC Program for assistance.

Thank you and your staff for your efforts in submitting your pre-book in a timely manner. This process will determine the California VFC Program's overall flu vaccine need and the amount of each flu vaccine product (by brand) to support VFC provider vaccination efforts for the entire 2025 – 2026 influenza season.
