## Immunization Reporting Extended for 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> Grades Until February 28, 2023

<u>California Health and Safety Code Section 120375 and California Code of Regulations Section 6075</u> require that all schools screen students for required vaccinations or valid exemptions and report student immunization status to the California Department of Public Health (CDPH). Instructions for reporting can be found at <a href="https://www.cdph.ca.gov/schoolreporting">www.cdph.ca.gov/schoolreporting</a> and the <a href="https://exemptions.new.cdph.ca.gov/schoolreporting">letter to schools</a>.

Our records indicate that one or more schools under your supervision are in violation of state law for failure to report student immunization status for the school year. If any of the delinquent schools you supervise are closed or do not have 7<sup>th</sup>/8<sup>th</sup> grade students this year, please sign-in to the reporting site to confirm the school's closure or lack of students. Please also contact California Department of Education (CDE) to correct the school's status for the CDE directory.

Please be aware that unless the delinquent school(s) reports student immunization status to CDPH before **the extended closing date of February 28, 2022**, your School Name will be referred to CDE for possible disciplinary action. Delinquent schools with 7th grades will also be listed as such on the CDPH and <a href="www.shotsforschool.org">www.shotsforschool.org</a> websites.
