# Immunization Reporting Extended for Preschool and Child Cares Until February 28, 2023

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[California Health and Safety Code Section 120375 and California Code of Regulations Section 6075](#) require that child care facilities screen enrollees for required vaccinations or valid exemptions and report enrollee immunization status to the California Department of Public Health (CDPH). Our records indicate that your child care facility is now in violation of state law for failure to report enrollee immunization status for the school year. **If any of the delinquent facilities you supervise do not have enrollees this year, please [sign-in to the reporting site](#) to confirm the child care facility's closure or lack of enrollees.** Then, contact California Department of Social Services (DSS) to correct the facility's status in the CDSS Directory.

Please be aware that unless your facility reports enrollee immunization status to CDPH before the **extended closing date of February 28, 2023**, your facility will be reported to the California Department of Social Services or California Department of Education for possible disciplinary action. Non-compliant child care facilities will also be listed as such on the CDPH website. If you have questions, contact your [local health department](#) directly.
