Respiratory Disease Immunization Recommendations for Children

COVID-19 (6 months+)	Strongly recommend updated vaccine for everyone. Children ages 6 months – 4 years should complete a multi-dose initial series, with at least one dose of the updated vaccine.											
Flu (6 months+)	Vaccinate children: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 6 months – 8 years who need 2 doses*, or • Who may not return in the fall 		Optimal vaccination: September and October		Continue vaccinating as long as flu is circulating, and unexpired vaccine is available.							
RSV (Nirsevimab) (0 – 19 months)**				Optimal administration: October 1 – March 31

Influenza Updates

Although [flu activity](#) has been declining, significant activity can continue into the spring. CDPH recommends that you **continue vaccinating until the last flu dose expires!** This season's flu vaccines have been shown to protect against flu-related medical visits and hospitalizations across all age groups.

Respiratory Syncytial Virus (RSV) Season Immunization Recommendations

This [CDPH graphic](#) summarizes the RSV season immunization recommendations, including infants and children, pregnant people, and adults age 60 years and older.

According to the [CDC Morbidity and Mortality Weekly Report \(MMWR\)](#), nirsevimab was 90% effective at protecting infants from RSV-association hospitalization. Refer to the [full report](#) for more details.
