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It's Not Too Late to Vaccinate!

Everyone 6 months and older should get updated COVID-19 and influenza vaccines. Those who are aged 65 years or older, or immunocompromised, should

also receive a second COVID-19 dose 6 months after the first (minimum interval 2 months). Infants and older adults who are eligible should get a Respiratory Syncytial Virus (RSV) immunization.

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VFA Ordering Window Extended!

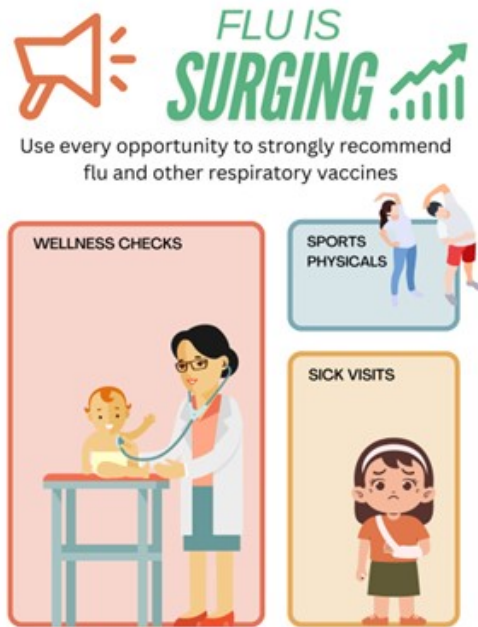
