Pfizer COVID-19 Vaccine (Comirnaty®) for 12 Years of Age and Up

Pfizer has notified the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) that between mid-February and mid-March doses shipped of their Comirnaty® COVID-19 vaccine for persons 12 years of age and up (NDC# 00069-2432-10) will have a shorter shelf life between 8-11 weeks. The shelf life for this direct ship vaccine at delivery is typically >12 weeks. Please plan your provider orders during this period with the shorter shelf life in mind and order enough doses that can be administered until your next routine vaccine order.

Note: This period of reduced shelf life does not apply to other Pfizer COVID-19 vaccines.
