

# **COVID-19 Vaccines: Preliminary Timeline**


The preliminary timeline for COVID-19 vaccines is as follows:

### **Vaccines for Children (VFC) Vaccine Ordering Updates**

#### **COVID-19 Vaccine Ordering**

VFC providers should continue ordering COVID-19 vaccine for their practices. For the VFC Program, COVID-19 vaccine product availability for the 2024 – 2025 season is as follows:

- Novavax: This product is no longer available for ordering. Latest doses that were distributed expired on April 30, 2025, and any remaining expired doses must be returned to McKesson.
- Pfizer and Moderna vaccines remain available for ordering with the following expiry parameters:

Trimester during July and August.

In jurisdictions with RSV seasonality that differs from most of the continental United States, including Alaska, southern Florida, Guam, Hawaii, Puerto Rico, U.S.-affiliated Pacific Islands, and U.S. Virgin Islands, providers should follow state, local, or territorial guidance. However, nirsevimab may be administered outside of routine seasonal administration (ie., October through March) based on local RSV activity and other special circumstances.

- Pfizer:
  - 6m-4y, 5-11y vaccine will have a minimum shelf life of 3 months upon delivery; viable for 10 weeks in the refrigerator
  - 12y+ vaccine has an expiry of September 6, 2025
- Moderna:
  - 6m-11y vaccine has an expiry of September 12, 2025
  - 12y+ vaccine has an expiry of September 14, 2025

#### 2024 – 2025 Flu Vaccine Ordering

The last day to order VFC flu vaccine for the 2024 – 2025 season is June 10, 2025. Most flu vaccine will expire on June 30, 2025, and the CDC will stop flu vaccine shipments 2 weeks prior to expiry. Ordering for flu vaccine will resume in the fall.
