Economic development operates within a dynamic system of:





## The Role of the Economic Development Organization within a System - Building Trust and "Standing" in the System

Economic developer as point guard – able to distribute work and responsibilities to those best able to act

Able to function regionally

Reliance on information, knowledge, and intelligence

Higher demand for transparency, nontraditional civic engagement/involvement – crowdsourcing, and social media

**Demand for metrics** 

Adaptability – comfort with complexity

# Prepare, Organize, Engage – Getting ready to build a successful adaptable process within an Economic Development System

**Prepare** – plan the process – Are we ready and who is "we"?, Do we have resources and capacity for the process?

**Organize** - Who is this plan for? Who benefits, is impacted, impacts/connects others? Individuals, organizations, networks, systems

**Engage** – How do we communicate internally and externally about the purpose and process? How do we engage for "commit-in" vs "buy in", Are we prepared, organized, and welcoming for diverse inclusion? - Multiple and creative methods welcome!
