We fulfill this mission through emergency financial assistance, disaster relief, education support, and community programs for Airmen, Guardians, and their families.



Financial Assistance was provided to the Total Force (Active Duty, Guard, and Reserve Airmen and Guardians), and 5% to retirees and widows

AFAS provided \$10.5 Million in direct assistance to over 14,000 Airmen, Guardians, and their families.


Basic Living \$2.3M // 31 %

Education Support Programs // \$2.7M

- Gen Henry H. Arnold Education Grants = \$2.6M
 - 1,383 grants ranging from \$500 to \$4,000 for dependent children & spouses
- Merit Scholarships = \$105K
 - 21 dependent scholars earned scholarships
- Supplemental Education Loans = \$52K
 - 43 families received no interest loans to help pay for incidental college expenses
